The 6th IRDES-DAUPHINE Workshop on Applied Health Economics and Policy Evaluation (AHEPE) was organized by IRDES, Institute for Research and Information in Health Economics, with the Chaire Santé Dauphine.

The workshop covers the following topics, with an emphasis on Public Policies analysis and evaluation: Social health inequalities, Health services utilization, Insurance, Health services delivery and organization, Specific populations : The Elderly, Migrants, High-Needs-High Costs Patients, Low Income Patients.

14 papers were selected by the scientific committee on the basis of a full or advanced draft written in English.

Due to the exceptional circumstances of this year, the workshop was carried out by videoconference in a new format. Each paper was presented by the discussant who gave an overview of the paper and his comments/suggestions, followed by a discussion with the authors and the participants (20 minutes in total).
