The 12th IRDES Workshop on Applied Health Economics and Policy Evaluation (AHEPE) is organized by IRDES, the Institute for Research and Information in Health Economics, and the Interdisciplinary Laboratory for Applied Research in Health Economics & Management (LIRAES).

The workshop covers a wide range of topics, relating to social health inequalities, health service organization and utilization, health insurance, long-term care with an emphasis on public policy analysis and evaluation.

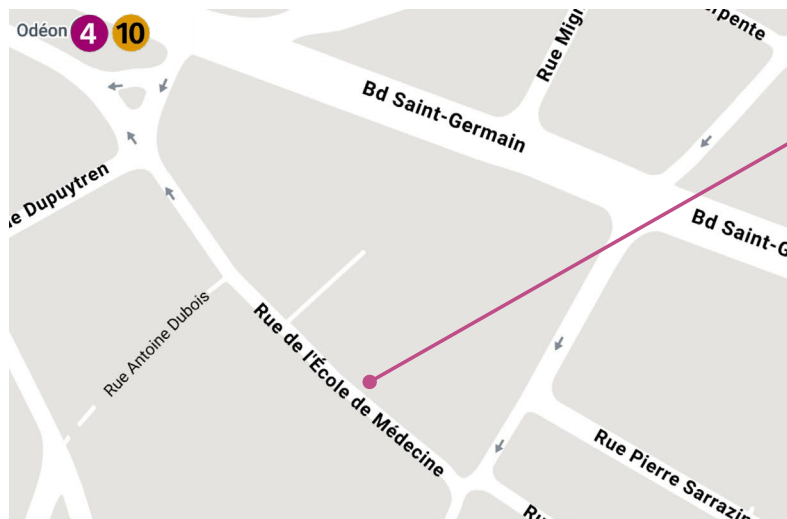

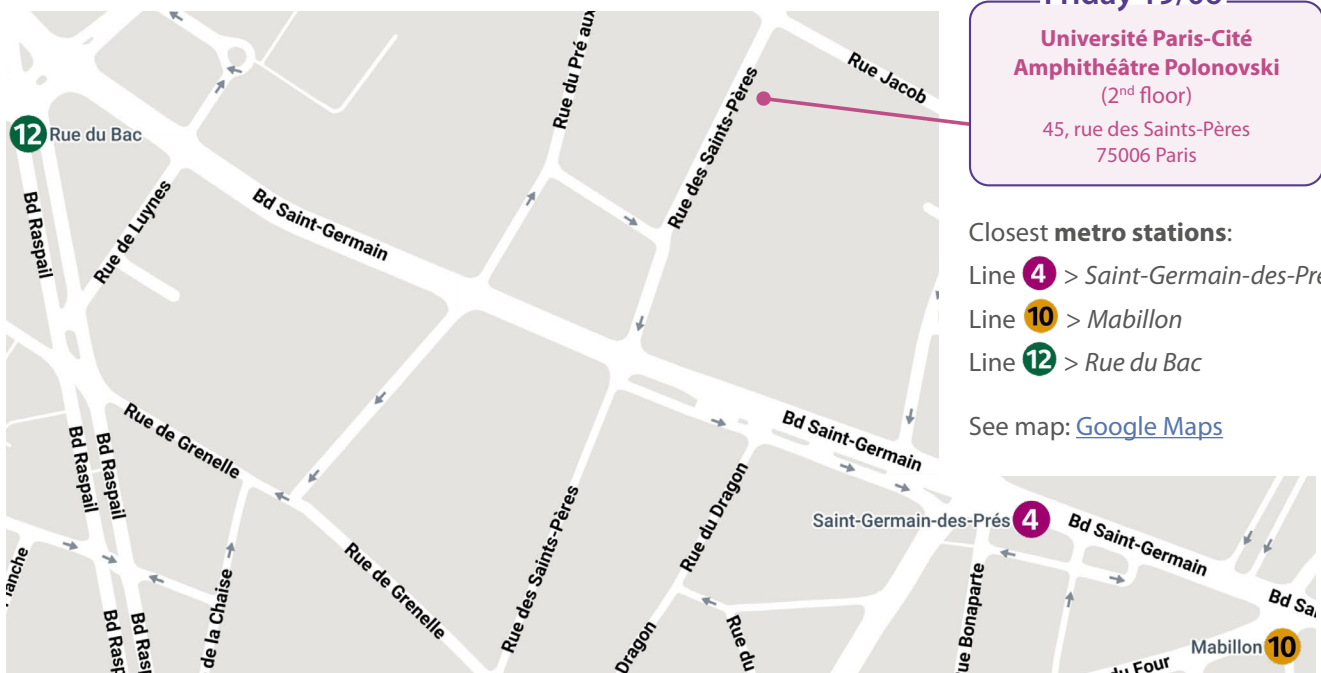
